INTRODUCTION

Potassium is involved with promoting root growth, maintaining stem strength, encouraging protein production and ensuring the efficiency of water use. Sulphur is necessary for nitrogen utilization and is vital for protein formation.

Shortages of potash in the plant cannot be rectified in-season using conventional fertilisers, which is why we have introduced KuruS.

Applications of KuruS should be made based on soil and/or plant tissue analysis for

DO NOT apply KuruS to the foliage of crops sensitive to sulphur.

Foliar fertiliser: 2.25 - 6.75 I/ha. Unless otherwise specified, apply in enough water to provide thorough coverage.

TIMING Potatoes:

Make the first application at tuber initiation, a second application 2 - 3

weeks later and a third application at tuber bulking. Cereals: Apply from tillering to early boot stage (GS 20 - 43).

Pulses: Apply from late bud to 10% flowers showing.

Apply from 4 - 6 leaf stage. Oilseed rape:

Apply from the beginning of fruit set and repeat every 10 - 14 days. Tomatoes: Apply in at least 270 litres of water, beginning 2 weeks after flowering. Vines:

Repeat every 7 - 10 days.

Apply in at least 900 litres of water. Make the first application at first full Apples:

It is recommended that soil and tissue analysis results are used whenever possible to guide micro and macronutrient applications to optimise crop nutrient status. Do not apply this product in very bright sunlight or in temperatures above 25°C. If possible, spray in the evening or early morning for best results.

APPLICATION

Stir well before use.

Spray equipment should be clean. Half fill the spray tank with water, begin agitation and add the required quantity of KuruS. Rinse the container thoroughly, add the rinsings to the spray-tank, complete the filling and apply without delay. Maintain agitation throughout. Clean sprayer thoroughly after use.

COMPATIBILITY

KuruS is physically and chemically compatible with a wide range of agrochemical products. Consult your supplier for the latest information. Up-to-date information is available at www.fmc-agro.co.uk. Always read the label of the partner product carefully before mixing with KuruS.

Blends of KuruS should not be acidified below pH6. Avoid mixing with highly acidic materials.

STORAGE

Protect from frost. Store above 5°C.
